THE CITY OF MONROE IS SEEKING VOLUNTEERS TO SERVE ON THE CITY BUDGET COMMITTEE

Typically 4-5 meetings a year a majority of them in May and June. You must be a registered voter within the City of Monroe. A letter of interest addressed to the Monroe City Council and the council hopes to fill the 3-4 slots at the March 27th council meeting. There are terms available for 1 year and 3 years.

The Budget Committee is made up of the 7-member council and 7 electors within the City. The city administrator is the appointed budget officer and will create and present a draft budget to the committee. The Budget Committee will conduct a public hearing and review, edit, change and approve with recommendations to the city council. Then the City Council will conduct a public hearing and review the budget and adopt it prior to June 30, 2017.
