PUBLIC WORKS UTILITY WORKER

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Performs manual, semi-skilled and skilled tasks in the maintenance of city parks, storm drains, streets, buildings and grounds. Will be the primary building cleaning maintenance staff for all City owned buildings and properties. May serve as support and backup for public works technician. **REQUIRES** Customer Service Training and Experience.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASSIFICATION:

This is a part-time, regular position with the major duties primarily to work with full-time Public Works Technician, clean and maintain City owned facilities with seasonal increase of hours for the mowing and maintenance of City parks. In addition, coverage for the Public Works Technician when they are off work or out of town for professional development events will be expected. Work hours will average 20 hours a week for 8 months of the year and 30 hours a week for four months a year. This employee is responsible for maintenance tasks for city utilities, buildings, park grounds and facilities, works as a member of a crew on street, water and sewer projects; will work independently on selected jobs.

Probation is for 6 months.

Starting Wage Based upon Experience (\$12 to \$15 hourly)
