

RESOLUTION 2019-01

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2019-2024 TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD FIVE YEAR IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF MONROE

WHEREAS; THE Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) requires Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) 5-Year Implementation Plan be adopted by Designated Management Agencies under OAR 340-042-0080(3); and

WHEREAS; THE City of Monroe last submitted a 5-year Plan in 2012; and

WHEREAS: The Resource Assistance for Rural Environments (RARE) Program, an Americorp Program administered by the Planning, Public Policy and Management Program at the University of Oregon has provided the increased organizational capacity for Monroe to address the TMDL requirements and plans; and

WHEREAS: Taylor Evans, Monroe RARE Participant 2018-2019 has within her approved and designated work plan successfully facilitated, negotiated and crafted a 5-Year TMDL Implementation Plan acceptable to DEQ and the City of Monroe;

NOW THEREFORE; The City Council for the City of Monroe finds that the development and submission to the DEQ of the City of Monroe's TMDL Implementation Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, is required to satisfy both DEQ's Water Quality Management Plan and the City's Designated Management Agency requirements under OAR 340-042-0080(3); and

NOW THEREFORE; that the City of Monroe's 2019-2024 TMDL Implementation Plan as attached as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.
