WHEREAS, each day, our First Responders stand ready to aid members of our community who are in need, often risking their own safety in the execution of their duties; and

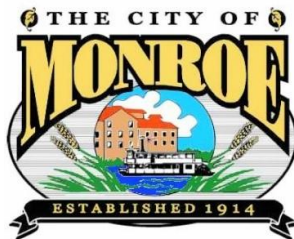
WHEREAS, our First Responders undergo extensive education and training in order to achieve the expertise required to respond to emergency situations; and
