- 3-year staggered term; expected time commitment of 5 meetings between April 1 and June 30.
- City of Monroe resident who has lived within city limits for a minimum of one-year prior to appointment.

Ordinance Committee Expectations and Requirements:

- One regular meeting per quarter; more meetings may be scheduled depending on committee work.
- The Committee is comprised of 3 Council members and 2 City of Monroe residents who have lived within city limits for a minimum of one-year prior to appointment.

Planning Commission Expectations and Requirements:

- One regular meeting, on the first Monday of each month, occasional work sessions.
- Monroe resident preferred or greater Monroe community member (i.e. Alpine, Bellfountain, Glenbrook, Ingram Island, Irish Bend or vicinity) required. Council appoints all members for a staggered, 4-year term.
- No more than two voting members of the commission may engage principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit as individuals, or be members of any partnership, or officers or employees of any corporation, that engages principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit. No more than two members shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation, business, trade or profession.
