



RESOLUTION NO. 2022-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND IMPLEMENTING CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH RESOURCE ASSISTANCE FOR RURAL ENVIRONMENTS (RARE) PROGRAM PARTICIPATION

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has numerous long-term planning and economic development projects with limited staff and resources in place; and

WHEREAS, the University of Oregon Americorps Program Resource Assistance for Rural Environments offer opportunity for participants to serve and gain experience in the community development and environmental administration planning field; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe City Council wishes to explore all potential options for increasing the level of community development including updating the Monroe Parks Master Plan, developing new park areas, and promoting the local level of the Oregon Main Street Program; and

WHEREAS, the City does desire to increase its active outreach program to the community especially as it relates to online communications and community gathering points, public safety, and fostering inclusiveness of the community through activities and education; and

WHEREAS, the City desires a community process for developing a new economic development plan through coordination with local and regional businesses; now

BE IT RESOLVED, the Monroe City Council hereby declares and determines the authorization to enter into a Contractual Agreement with RARE in the funding and sponsorship of a RARE participant for the 2022-2023 year and authorizes all expenditures necessary to implement said program not to exceed \$23,500 in direct costs and authorizes Mayor Sheets to sign documentation implementing the agreement.
